ATHLETICS FACILITIES

Madonna University has three facilities its teams call home. The Madonna University Activities Center and the Madonna University Baseball and Softball Complex are located on the university grounds. Greenmeade Field (Soccer), Idyl Wyld Golf Course, Whispering Willows Golf Course and Fox Creek Golf Course are located off campus.

Activities Center

The home of the Madonna University Volleyball team, as well as the Men's and Women's Basketball team, provides the type of raucous atmosphere visiting teams dread. During its run as the home arena for these teams, it has seen its teams win numerous conference and tournament titles, in addition to making a number of national tournament runs. The 1,500 person complex underwent a facelift for the 2003 season, with the floor getting a major re-finishing.

The Activities Center features bleacher seating along the length of the court, going six rows deep. A concession stand provides Crusader fans with anything from pizza to popcorn. The Activities Center also plays host to many local, regional and national tournaments at the high school and collegiate level. Located next to the main academic building of Madonna University, Activities Center parking is available from either the Levan Road entrance or the Schoolcraft Road exit. The entrances are east and south of the Activities Center respectively.

The Activities Center can be accessed via the following routes:

From Lansing/Grand Rapids area:

Take I-96 east to I-275 south back to I-96 east, exit at the Newburgh/Levan Rds. Exit. Proceed east on Schoolcraft Rd. (I-96 service drive) to Levan Rd. Turn left on Levan and the University is in front of you on the left. Turn left into the first driveway and the Student Activities Center is on your left.

From Ft. Wayne/Jackson area:

Take I-69 north to I-94 east to M-14 east to I-96 east, exit at the Newburgh/Levan Rds. exit. Proceed east on Schoolcraft Rd. (I-96 service drive) to Levan Rd. Turn left on Levan and the University is in front of you on the left. Turn left into the first driveway and the Student Activities Center is on your right.

From Toledo - South:

Take US-23 north to M-14 East to I-96 east, exit at the Newburgh/Levan Rds. Exit. Proceed east on Schoolcraft Rd. (I-96 service drive) to Levan Rd. Turn left on Levan and the University is in front of you on the left. Turn left into the first driveway and the Student Activities Center is on your right.

From Ann Arbor - West:

Take I-94 east to I-275 north to I-96 east, exit at the Newburgh/Levan Rds. Exit. Proceed east on Schoolcraft Rd. (I-96 service drive) to Levan Rd. Turn left on Levan and the University is in front of you on the left. Turn left into the first driveway and the Student Activities Center is on your right.

From Chicago - West:

Take I-94 east into Michigan, and proceed to I-275 north to I-96 east, exit at the Newburgh/Levan Rds. Exit. Proceed east on Schoolcraft Rd. (I-96 service drive) to Levan Rd. Turn left on Levan and the University is in front of you on the left. Turn left into the first driveway and the Student Activities Center is on your right.

ATHLETICS FACILITIES

Madonna University Baseball Field

The 2004 season will mark the beginning of a new era for Crusader Baseball, with the opening of a new baseball field. The \$1 million project boasts a state of the art irrigation system, professional playing surface and on grade dugouts. The 1,000 seat stadium features dimensions of 325 feet down the lines, 370 feet in the gaps and 395 feet in straight-away center. With 15,000 yards of Kentucky Blue Grass sod, the playing surface is instantly one of the best in Michigan.

The field is located north of the softball field, next to Ladywood High School. To get there from the main academic building of Madonna University, head west on Schoolcraft Road until you hit Newburgh Road (approx. 1/2 mile). Turn right on Newburgh Road and head north for 3/4 mile until you see Ladywood High School on the right hand side. Make a right into the main parking lot of the high school. The baseball field is north of both softball diamonds.

Madonna University Park

The park enters its 7th season as home to the Madonna University Softball Team. The park holds 1,000 people and features bleacher seating or lawn seating, all with excellent sight lines. The field has dimensions of 200 feet down the lines and 225 feet to the center field wall. With the baseball field moving in as its neighbor for the 2004 season, there is sure to be a great deal of action at the corner of 5 mile and Newburgh.

(See Madonna University Baseball Field for Directions) - The softball field is the second diamond in the complex.

Greenmead Field

Located on the same grounds as the Hill House Museum, Livonia Historical Village and Hill House Gardens, the Greenmead complex also is home to the Madonna University Men's and Women's Soccer Teams. Greenmead Field has proven to house the kind of home field advantage any team would want, as both teams went a combined 16-0-2 last season. The field offers both bleacher and lawn seating, and can hold up to 1,000 people.

To reach Greenmead Field turn right onto Schoolcraft Road. Turn right onto Newburgh Road. Proceed north on Newburgh. The field is located on the left hand side of Newburgh Road just north of Seven Mile Road.

Fox Creek

This Livonia Public Course will be the home for the inaugural season of Men's and Women's Golf at Madonna University. This 18-hole course has everything to offer to the golfer who wants to be challenged. Tight fairways, water hazards and sand traps are featured throughout the course and frustrate even the best of golfers. Whether it is a tournament or a friendly scramble, Fox Creek is the perfect compliment to any round.

To get to Fox Creek from the main academic building of Madonna University, turn left on Levan Road and head north for two miles to 7 Mile Road. Turn right on 7 Mile and head east for 1/2 mile. Course will be on left hand side.

Stat Programs: The Madonna SID office uses The Automated Scorebook (TAS) for baseball, softball, volleyball and soccer. Cybersports is used for men's and women's basketball.

Seating: Seating is available for media at volleyball, baseball, softball and basketball contests.

Telephones: Telephones and a FAX machine are available for media use in the Madonna Athletic Department at the conclusion of each contest.
